Starter Packs Inverclyde has been running successfully since 2002. CHIP supported them at the origins of the project by assisting and establishing a steering group. We helped the steering group to draft their constitution, then advised them on funding options and provided them with a Seedcorn grant.

Today Starter Packs Inverclyde is a sustainable charitable organisation supported by various funders such as Scottish Power and Children in Need.

The project co-ordinated by June Glancy with the support of 10 volunteers provides 150 to 200 packs a year to families and single people moving on to a new tenancy after experiencing homelessness. Nothing could be possible without the twenty churches involved who organise collections of donations. June's team help people to make their new house a real home by providing good quality items – new or used. They provide bedding, cleaning materials, curtains, crockery, pots and hygiene packs. They make the difference by adding small items to personalise the pack: a small toy for a young child or a book for a teenager.
